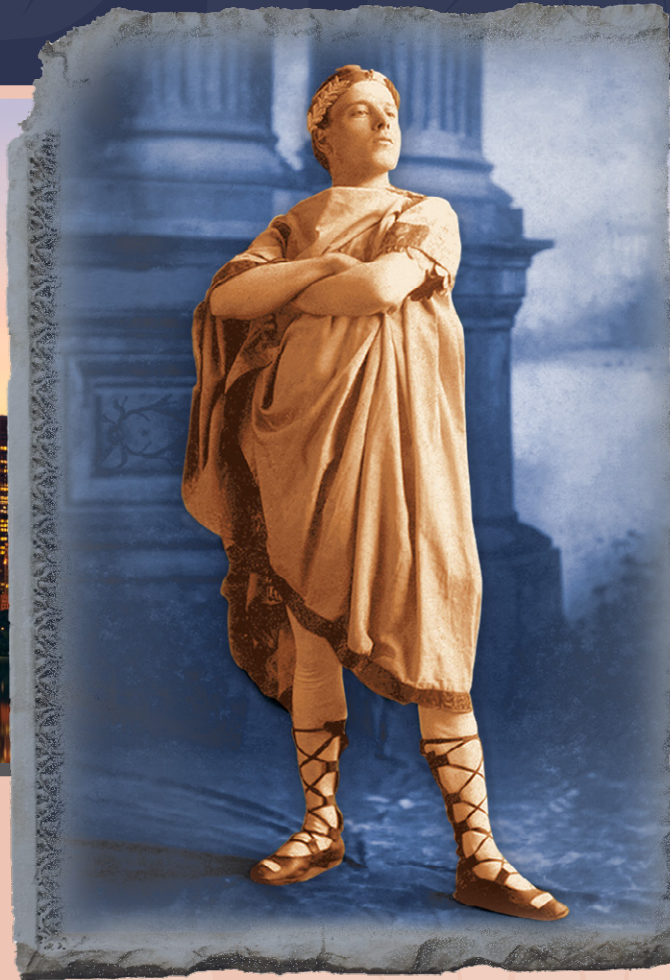

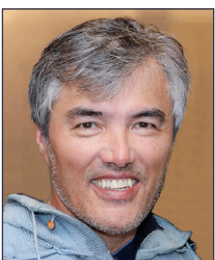

Advice for Early Career (and Beyond...)

Dean Elliott, MD, FASRS, is the S.E. Gragoudas Professor of Ophthalmology, Director Emeritus of the Retina Service, and Director of the Retina Fellowship at Massachusetts Eye and Ear of Harvard Medical School.

Dr. Elliott received his undergraduate degree with honors from Duke University, and he received his medical degree with honors from Vanderbilt University School of Medicine. He completed his residency at the Wilmer Eye Institute of Johns Hopkins Hospital, and he received his retina fellowship training at the Duke Eye Center of Duke University Medical Center. He then served as Chief Resident and retina faculty member at Duke.

Following this, Dr. Elliott was the Director of the Retina Service, Associate Professor, and Retina Fellowship Director at the Kresge Eye Institute of Wayne State University School of Medicine. Subsequently, he was the Director of the Doheny Retina Institute, Professor, and Retina Fellowship Director at the Doheny Eye Institute of the University of Southern California Keck School of Medicine.

Dr. Elliott has received numerous teaching awards, including the Crystal Apple Award from the American Society of Retina Specialists and the Lifetime Mentor Award from the Vit-Buckle Society. He has participated in all of the major annual fellowship teaching conferences, including the Mass. Eye & Ear Vitrectomy Course, Fellows' Forum, the Duke Vitrectomy Course, Jump Start Retina, and Transitions into Clinical Practice. He has been a principal investigator for many clinical trials, including sustained-release drug implants, the Argus II retinal prosthesis, stem cell-derived retinal pigment epithelial cell transplants, stem cell-derived retinal progenitor cell transplants, and gene therapy studies. He is on the editorial board for several journals, and he has over 300 publications in ophthalmic journals and textbooks. Dr. Elliott has special interest in diabetic retinopathy, retinal detachment, trauma, proliferative vitreoretinopathy, and surgery for complex retina-vitreous disorders.
